To this end, the Division of Engineering and Technology implemented various projects in line with the Strategy which was adopted by the Fifth Islamic Conference of Ministers of Higher Education and Scientific Research held in October 2010 in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia, to renew the commitments of the concerned authorities in the Member States, to promote investments, and cooperation among the member countries. The International Workshop on Nanotechnology organized in Dhaka international Workshop in nanotechnology covered all important branches of nanotechnology and closely-related interdisciplinary fields like Health, Medicine, Food, Agriculture, Energy and Environment, ICT and Electronic Devices and Industry and Consumer Products. The workshop conducted a Panel discussion on Nanotechnology- Research and **Education: Bangladesh Perspectives**
