#### **STATISTICS**


• To collate, process and disseminate socioeconomic statistics and information on and for the utilisation of the member countries




#### OTCStat


#### Hide Sections

  and judicial structure, and political parties and leaders.

GDP, GDP per capits, GDP growth rate, education eigendurint, health expendition, unemployment rate, economic complexity sore, FDI, ODA, exports and imports figures with trade partners and intra-OIC realisations, important natural resources, and main agricultural products.







#### OIC STATISTICAL CAPACITY BUILDING PROGRAMME (STATCAB)



  - Workshop on 'The Impact of Post-2015 Development Agenda on Education Statistics' in November 2016






